

Call for Exhibitions at INTERSPEECH2010

INTERSPEECH 2010 (<http://www.interspeech2010.org/>), the world's largest academic conference in spoken language processing, welcomes industrial and academic institutions to showcase career opportunities, products, research, services, and technologies.

The exhibition will take place for 4 days, from Monday 27 September 2010 (the second day of INTERSPEECH 2010) through Thursday 30 September 2010 (the last day of INTERSPEECH 2010).
